Hodge Ideals and Spectrum of Isolated Hypersurface Singularities

This is a series of talks on the paper, Hodge ideals and spectrum of isolated hypersurface singularities, by Seung-Jo Jung, In-Kyun Kim, Morihiko Saito and Youngho Yoon. The spectrum is an important analytic invariant of hypersurface singularities and Hodge ideals are ideal sheaves regarded as a generalization of multiplier ideals. Nero Budur and Morihiko Saito found a relation between spectrum and multiplier ideals. We extend their result to Hodge ideals in case of isolated singularities. There will be 4 hours of talks:
